If a fire breaks out in your home	Verbally raise the alarm by shouting "FIRE, FIRE, FIRE", knock on any
	doors that you pass and repeat this call throughout your escape until you
	leave the building.
	Warn all persons within your flat and leave together.
	Where possible turn off any cooking equipment.
	Where possible close windows and doors, <b>but especially the front door.</b>
	Do not attempt to put out the fire.
	Do not put yourself at risk.  Do Not use the Lift.
	Activate the manual call point near the exit door if in the car park.
	Exit the building by using the nearest fire protected staircase and move to
	a safe assembly area away from the building near the entrance to the
	estate. Call the fire service. (999 OR 112)
If you see or hear of a fire in	Although the building is constructed with a high degree of fire protection

	the safe assembly area when they hear the fire alarm sounder or vocal cry.
	You must also leave <b>immediately</b> if smoke or heat affects your home, or if
	you are told to do so by the fire service.
	If in doubt, <b>get out</b> and move to a safe assembly area away from the
	building.

Arrangements for the safe	Details of any individuals with special needs should be kept near the

	the property manager so that an assessment can be made based on their

Plans to deal with persons once	All evacuated personnel should remain at a safe assembly point away from
they have left the premises	the building. No individual should re-enter the building for any reason
	until they have been instructed to do so.
Assembly Point	The assembly point for evacuated personnel should be at a safe distance
	(approximately 40-50m) at the entrance to the estate.
