How people will be warned if there is a fire.	An automatic fire alarm with manual break glass points is installed throughout the building that will sound on detection of any fire.
	It is assessed although not confirmed that and independent alarm is fitted within each flat that will sound in single flat only.
If a fire breaks out in your	Verbally raise the alarm by shouting "Fire".
home	Warn all persons within your apartment and leave together.
	Where possible turn off your cooker or oven. Where possible close windows and doors, especially the front door.
	Do not attempt to put out the fire.
	Do not put yourself at risk. On exiting the flat and evacuating the building residents should trigger
	the nearest manual activation point. Then leave the building by the
	nearest available exit and move to a safe distance from the block.
	Call the fire service.
If you see or hear of a fire in	The evacuation plan for this building requires all residents to

	You must also leave immediately if smoke or heat affects your

	If in doubt, get out and move to a safe distance from the block.
