In the event of Fire	Action
How people will be warned if there is a fire.	Ceiling mounted smoke and heat alarms are fitted within each flat that are interlinked and will sound in the individual flat only. A communal alarm is fitted but this will not sound inside of the flats.
If a fire breaks out in your home	Verbally raise the alarm by shouting "FIRE, FIRE, FIRE", knock on any doors that you pass and repeat this call throughout your escape until you leave the building. Residents should operate the break glass point on exiting the building to warn others of the emergency. Warn all persons within your flat and leave together. Where possible turn off any cooking equipment. Where possible close windows and doors, but especially the front door. Do not attempt to put out the fire. Do not put yourself at risk. Do Not use the Lift. Exit the building and move to the safe assembly area away from the
If you see or hear of a fire in another part of the building	Although the building is constructed with a high degree of fire protection the evacuation plan for this building requires all residents to proceed to the safe assembly area when they hear any vocal cry or alarm sounder. You must also leave immediately if smoke or heat affects your home, or if you are told to do so by the fire service. If in doubt, get out and move to the safe assembly area away from the building.
Hearing the alarm (relevant persons who may be elsewhere in the building	Evacuate the building immediately but do not use the lift. If you have visitors or contractors with you, instruct them to follow you. Move to the safe assembly area away from the building.
How will the emergency services be notified and who is responsible	The person finding the fire should dial 999 or 112 . When the operator answers, give your telephone number and ask for FIRE. When the fire service replies give the address where the fire is: Doc Fictoria, Caernarfon, LL55 1SQ. Do not end the call until the fire service has repeated the address correctly.
Arrangements for the safe evacuation of people identified as being especially at risk	Details of any individuals with special needs should be kept in a suitable fire contents box near the entrance for easy identification by the emergency services.
Plans to deal with persons once they have left the premises	All evacuated personnel should remain at a safe assembly point away from the building. No individual should re-enter the building for any reason until they have been instructed to do so.
Assembly Point	The assembly point for evacuated personnel should be at a safe distance (approximately 40-50m) to the front of the building on the opposite side of the estate.
