If a fire breaks out in your home	Verbally raise the alarm by shouting "Fire".

	Where possible turn off your cooker or oven.
	Where possible close windows and doors, especially the front door.
	Do not attempt to put out the fire. Do not put yourself at risk.
	Do not use the lifts.
	Leave the building by the nearest available exit and activate a fire alarm
