How people will be warned if	An automatic fire alarm is fitted within the common areas that will sound
there is a fire.	in the stairs and landings only.
	Additionally, Grade D Smoke detectors are fitted inside each flat that will provide warning independently within each flat.
If a fire breaks out in your home	Verbally raise the alarm by shouting "FIRE, FIRE, FIRE, FIRE "and repeat this call
	throughout your escape until you leave the building. Activate the nearest
	Manual Call Point (red break glass alarm control).
	Warn all persons within your flat and leave together.
	Where possible turn off any cooking equipment.
	Where possible close windows and doors, <b>but especially the front door.</b> Do not attempt to put out the fire.
	Do not put yourself at risk.
	Do Not use the Lift.
	Exit the building by nearest exit and move to a safe place away from the

	Call the fire service. (999 OR 112)
If you see or hear of a fire in another part of the building	Although the building is constructed with a high degree of fire protection the evacuation plan for this building requires all residents to proceed to a safe place away from the block when they hear any <b>vocal cry</b> or <b>alarm</b> . You must also leave <b>immediately</b> if smoke or heat affects your home, or if you are told to do so by the fire service. If in doubt, <b>get out</b> .
Hearing the alarm (relevant	Evacuate the building immediately by using the protective fire staircase.
persons who may be elsewhere	If you have visitors or contractors with you, instruct them to follow you.
